

**PERMIT TECH CODE CONSISTENCY MEMBER MEETING

We discussed the goal of our committee and came up with the following sentence that best describes what we want to accomplish:

Goal

To promote communication and consistency to better serve the community and streamline the process by becoming more informative for public safety and understanding in a user friendly environment.

We discussed the following questions:

1. Temporary CO's
 - a. Delaware County—making temp co's for residential go away. Will have to final house.
 - b. City of Dublin—issues temp Co's and contractor and owner have to sign.
 - c. Grove City-Temporary CO's are issued from Nov. 1st thru March 31st only and issued only for grade or exterior items. The Temp CO is signed only by the CBO.
 - d. Russells Point—Only issue Temp Co's for living in a house while remodeling
 - e. Pam Hickok—Do not issue Temp CO's
 - f. Union County-Issue Temp CO's anytime of the year and length of CO is dependent on type of work to be done. Maximum time is 180 days. The Temp co is signed by the inspector and the owner or agent.

2. How are building permit resubmittals and revisions handled?
Delaware County, ~~City of Dublin~~—small revisions do not need to be submitted
submittal Union County, Grove City—All revisions are resubmitted.
